Mary's Children Bookstore


The bookstore was completed in 2001 and offers a wide variety of religious articles such as rosaries, medals, statues, etc., as well as a

Mother of the Redeemer Retreat Center

Durpose

The Mother of the Redeemer Farm is dedicated to the Mother of Jesus and is a place of peace, personal prayer, and healing in a busy and fractured world. Here, in the beautiful hills of central Indiana, God's people, in all their diversity are welcomed in the peace of Christ. A life-size statue of Our Lady of Fatima greets visitors from the hillside upon their arrival. This statue is pictured on the front of the brochure.

As of 2005 the retreat center has been under the spiritual care and direction of the Franciscans of the Immaculate. The friars, along with dedicated lay volunteers, attend to the needs of those who come for spiritual rest and renewal. The retreat center follows all the liturgical norms of the Roman Catholic Church in all of its spiritual exercises.





The facilities of the Retreat Center, or "The Farm" as it is more popularly known, have improved significantly since the early 1990's. All of the buildings are air-conditioned and easily accessible by those who are handicapped.

The Dining Hall, completed in 2002, offers pilgrims attending retreats, staying in the Guest House excellent meals in a quiet, serene atmosphere. In addition to the Dining Hall for large groups, there is also an Annex Dining Hall with its own kitchenette for small groups or families.

The Guest House, completed in 1999 and located to the left of the main entrance as you enter the Retreat Center from West State Road 48, provides a place for peaceful meditation and prayer while staying at the Retreat Center. The Guest House has 30 furnished rooms, each consisting of a private bathroom and shower, two queen-size beds, a table and chair with a lamp. ocated on the hillside are the Rosary Path and Stations of the Cross. The Stations of the Cross follow a path up the hillside that ends at the Retreat Center Chapel. The Chapel of the Resurrection and the Glorification of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, located at the top of the hill and overlooking the Retreat Center, was completed in 1997 and is the Heart of the Retreat Center where Our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament is reserved for the adoration of the faithful. Daily Mass, Confession, and other devotions are conducted in the Chapel on a regular basis. To the right of the Chapel there is a shrine in memory of aborted babies. The Chapel is accessible either by walking the Stations of the Cross path or by car via Garrison Chapel Road to Hendricks Road and a right turn onto David Drive.



Activities

Activities at the Retreat Center include:

- Daily Holy Hour with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- Marian Days of prayer and reflection
- Corpus Christi procession and Marian processions
- Guided retreat every third weekend of the month, except the months of November and December in which the dates will be announced. No retreat sponsored by the center during the month of August.

Franciscan Friars of the Immaculate

In 2005, at the invitation of the Archbishop, the Franciscan Friars

of the Immaculate arrived to provide spiritual care and direction for those coming to the Retreat Center. The friars, along with dedicated lay volunteers, attend to the needs of those who come for spiritual rest and renewal.
